**Qualities of Prayer**

What should we seek in prayer?  
 Whatever tends to the glory of God and the salvation of our soul and that of our neighbor.  
 When we pray, what should we desire first?  
 Eternal life, and the supernatural charity that leads to it. All other goods we should desire only as means for gaining heaven: “Seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things shall be yours as well”  
 Is it lawful to ask for temporal blessings from God?  
 Yes. We may entreat Him for all our needs: health, food, clothing, protection from evils and accidents, the preservation of our loved ones, success in good undertakings, peace in our homeland, victory over enemies, etc.  
 How should we ask for these temporal things?  
 We should always ask for them: 1. *Conditionally*, i.e., provided that they are not obstacles to our salvation; 2. *Humbly*, with perfect submission to the will of God.
